Quick Guide to Obtaining a Marriage License in Clay County, Texas

- Marriage licenses may be issued to applicants at the County Clerk's office at 214 N. Main St, Henrietta, Texas
- You may obtain a marriage license anytime Monday-Friday (except holidays) from 8:00 am-11:30 pm and from 1:00 pm- 4:00 pm.
- You both must apply in person in the County Clerk's Office
- You both must be over 18 years of age
- You both must have a valid photo ID with DOB (driver's license or passport)
- You both must know your social security number, address, city and county of birth
- There is a **72 hour waiting period** before you may get married (unless a Judge waives the waiting period, if you are active duty military, or unless you complete a Texas Education course)
- The license expires in 90 days
- If divorced, it must be for over 30 days
- The fee is **\$82.00- No checks**. If you have completed a marriage course, and have a certificate of completion, the fee is \$22.00
- The Clay County Clerk is ordained to perform marriages. Must make appointment if you wish to be married by the clerk.
- You may use the Clay County-issued marriage license anywhere in Texas.
